GUIDELINES FOR DECISION MAKING

1. PRAY.

James 1:5 Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives to all generously and without criticizing, and it will be given to him.

2. GATHER FACTS. Nehemiah 2:11-15

- Define the decision as clearly as possible on paper.
- Gather as much information as necessary.
- List all available options.

3. CONSULT YOUR PRIORITIES.

Philippians 1:23-25 I am pressured by both. I have the desire to depart and be with Christ—which is far better [for me]—²⁴ but to remain in the flesh is more necessary for you. ²⁵ Since I am persuaded of this, I know that I will remain and continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith"

4. REALIZE <u>DESIRES</u>

Psalm 37:4 Take delight in the LORD, and He will give you your heart's desires.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God who is working in you, enabling you both to desire and to work out His good purpose.

5. SEEK COUNSEL.

Proverbs 12:15 A fool's way is right in his own eyes, but whoever listens to counsel is wise.

Proverbs 13:10 Arrogance leads to nothing but strife, but wisdom is gained by those who take advice.

Proverbs 19:20 Listen to counsel and receive instruction so that you may be wise later in life.

Proverbs 11:14 Without guidance, people fall, but with many counselors there is deliverance.

6. LISTEN TO GOD.
