"Train up a child (Youth) in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV)

The family has fallen victim to the American culture. American Family Association research shows:

- 1. Only <u>34 percent</u> of America's families eat one meal together each day.
- 2. The average father spends only <u>eight to 10 minutes</u> a day with his children, this includes television and meal times.
- 3. Only 12 percent of America's families pray together.
- 4. Average couple spends only <u>four minutes</u> of uninterrupted time together a day.

- 1. We must understand the <u>imperative</u> of the home and family. "*Train up* . . ."
- 2. We must understand the <u>initiation</u> of the home and family. "Train up a <u>child</u> (Youth)..."
- 3. We must understand the <u>instruction</u> of the home and family. "Train up a child *in the way he <u>should</u> go...*"
- 4. Eventually, all that is left are the <u>impressions</u> made through the home and family. "Train up a child in the way he should go, *and* <u>when he is old</u> <u>he will not depart from it</u>."
