### I) An Attack On Easy Living: (6:1)

A) Everybody works for, longs for, and strives for an easier life. That’s called progress.

B) Contentment is being satisfied with what you have.

Complacency is being satisfied with the way things are.

C) Contentment is being satisfied with God’s love for you!

Complacency is being satisfied with your love for God!

## II) A Warning Of Approaching Danger: (2-3)

A) Complacency is a most dangerous thing.

*“Therefore, let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.”* I Cor. 10:12

B) The deadliest thing for marriages is complacency. We don’t just quit loving each other; we drift apart.

C) In our relationship with God we grow cold.

## III) An Indictment For Insensitivity: (4-6)

A) Their compassion was dried up.

B) The problem we have with our compassion for people is a bigger problem than we know.
