I) Walking In Fellowship With God: (vs. 1)

A) Therefore to walk with God “we must not walk in the counsel of the ungodly...” or follow evil men’s advice. “nor stand in the path of sinner...” that is hang around with those who are enemies of God. “Nor sit in the seats of the scornful...” Keeping company with who are scoffing God.

B) Therefore, we must get out of the sin business. And disassociate ourselves with the practice of sinning. How? Decide this is not the way.

II) Delighting In The Word Of God: (vs. 2)

A) Delighting in something doesn’t happen spontaneously.

B) Delight is not something that comes easy. I delight in a beautiful mowed lawn, beautiful flowers, and fresh mulched beds but that takes effort.

III) Growing In The Grace Of God: (vs. 3)

A) You will never be happy without growing.

B) Growing in grace means to bear the fruit of grace, the fruit of the Spirit.

IV) Trusting In The Righteousness Of God: (vs.4-6)

A) The ungodly lived in an insecure life. (vs. 4)
The ungodly lived in a condemned life. (vs. 5)
The ungodly live a wasted life. (vs. 6)

B) Happiness is only a reality if we can face God without fear.
